

Section VIII: Commitment and Release Trends

Section VIII presents information from the Kentucky Department of Corrections (DOC) on prison admissions, commitments, sentences, and releases for Part I offenses, and from the Parole Board on hearings, paroles, deferrals, and serve-outs.

- In 2011, the average daily inmate population ranged from a low of 296 at the Bell County Forestry Camp to a high of 1,896 at the Kentucky State Reformatory.
- The total number of persons under DOC supervision increased from 62,305 in 2010 to 63,148 in 2011. The inmate population increased from 20,580 in 2010 to 21,704 in 2011, and the probation and parole population was down 0.6% from 41,725 in 2010 to 41,444 in 2011.
- In 2011, 64.7% of prison admissions were new commitments and the remaining 35.3% were returning parole violators.
- In 2011, the average sentence for specified Group A offenses ranged from a high of 24 years for Murder to a low of 8 years for Burglary and Auto Theft. The average sentence for all specified Group A offenses was 14.13 years, with an average of 18.25 years for Violent Offenses and 10 years for Property Offenses.
- The number of new commitments for Rape, Larceny/Theft, and Arson all decreased between 2010 and 2011. During this same time period, the number of new commitments for Auto Theft, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Murder, and Burglary increased.
- In 2011, 51.1% of those cases considered by the Kentucky Parole Board were granted parole.
