OJP Award Condition

- Requires advance determination regarding suitability for certain individuals who may interact with minors who receive grant-funded services
- Identifies required sex offender registry, child abuse registry, and criminal history searches that must be performed when making determining suitability
- Defines factors which must be considered, including factors that automatically disqualify an individual from being found suitable
- Establishes schedule for required updates and reexaminations of an individual's suitability



JPSC GMD Award Condition Enhancements

- Requirement to Maintain a Written Policy
- Updates to Reexamination Schedule



Award Condition Enhancement 1 Requirement to Maintain Written Policy

Subrecipients must implement formal, written policies and procedures that:

- (a) document the factors and considerations that will be considered in making determinations regarding suitability
- (b) identify the specific public sex offender and child abuse websites/registries, criminal history registries, and similar repositories of criminal history records that will be searched when making determinations regarding suitability, and
- (c) address "personally-accompanied contact" situations as defined in paragraph 3(c)(2) of the OJP award condition.

Award Condition Enhancement 2 Updates and Reexamination Schedule

Subrecipients must update all required searches specified within this policy and reexamine the covered individual's suitability in light of those search results **every two (2) years**. When appropriate, the determination must be modified or withdrawn.

Determination of Suitability

Subrecipients may not permit any covered individual to interact with any participating minor in the course of activities under the award, unless the subrecipient first has made a written determination of the suitability of that individual to interact with participating minors.



Each determination must be based on current and appropriate information and take into account the factors and considerations described in the award condition in determinations regarding suitability.



Definitions

COVERED INDIVIDUAL

Any individual who is expected, or reasonably likely, to interact with a participating minor

Includes, but may not be limited to:

- EmployeeContractor
- Volunteer
- Consultant Trainee

Teacher

Excludes: Participating minors or other service recipients; individuals only expected to interact with their own minor children



Definitions

PARTICIPATING MINOR

All individuals under 18 years of age who take part in, or are beneficiaries of, a grant-funded program

INTERACTION

Includes: Physical contact, oral and written communication, and the transmission of images and sound, and may be in person or by electronic or similar means

Excludes: Brief and unexpected contact; personally-accompanied contact



Required Searches

Must be performed no earlier than 6 months before determining an individual's suitability

Required Searches

All criminal history searches must be fingerprint-based, if legally available.

Criminal History Registries and Similar Repositories of Criminal History Records	
Searches must encompass at least the time period beginning five (5) calendar years	
preceding the date of the search request.	
Criminal history registry for each state in which the individual lives, works, or goes to school, or has lived, worked, or gone to school at any time during the past five (5) years	Required
Criminal history registry for each state in which the individual is expected to, or reasonably likely to, interact with a participating minor in the course of activities under the award.	Required



OJP Award Condition: Factors and Considerations in Determinations Regarding Suitability

- Determinations must be based on current and appropriate information
- OJP award condition identifies factors that automatically and permanently disqualify an individual from working with minors
- Other factors and considerations under the subrecipient's written policies and procedures



Documentation Requirements

Subrecipients must maintain all documentation related to written determinations of suitability for the duration of the records retention period. These records will be reviewed by GMD during compliance monitoring engagements and may be requested by GMD at any time.

- 1. Written determinations of suitability for all covered individuals
- 2. All records and reports generated through completion of required searches
- 3. Determination of Suitability to Interact with Participating Minors Certification Form
