

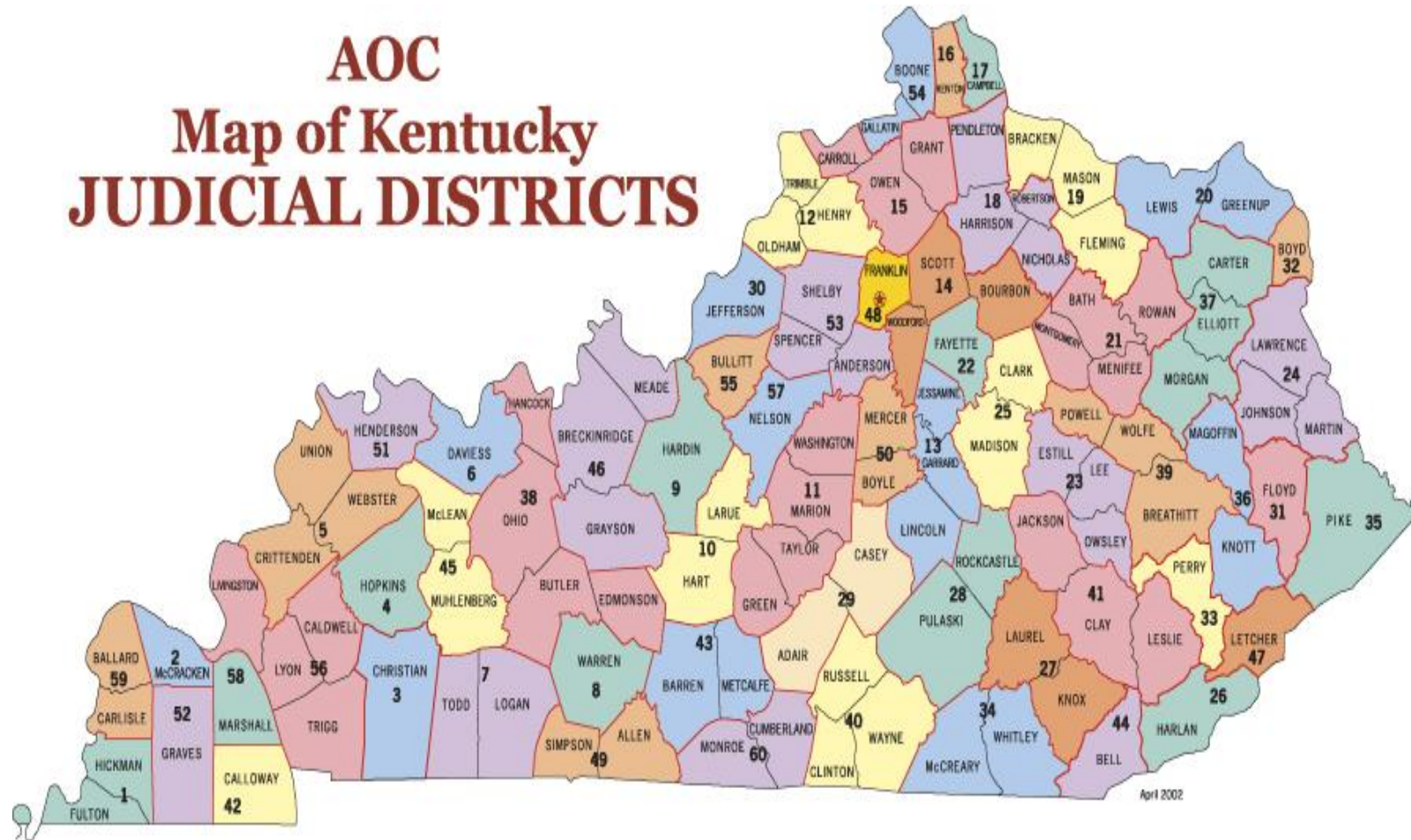
Section VII: Trial Court Caseload Trends

Section VII presents Circuit and District Court case data from the Kentucky Administrative Office of the Courts and data from the Department of Public Advocacy.

- Statewide, the number of criminal cases disposed in Circuit and District Courts increased from 30,779 in 2010 to 31,320 in 2011.
- The number of criminal cases disposed in Circuit Court varies greatly by Circuit. In 2011, the number of criminal cases disposed ranged from a high of 4,632 in the Thirtieth Judicial District (Jefferson County) to a low of 168 in the Thirty-Sixth Judicial District (Knott and Magoffin Counties).
- The number of felony cases disposed in District Court ranged from a high of 14,568 in the Thirtieth District Court (Jefferson County) to a low of 139 in the Fifty-Ninth District Court (Ballard and Carlisle Counties) in 2011.
- In 2011, the Department of Public Advocacy handled 108,551 cases. Of these, 70.5% were District Court cases, 28.4% were tried in Circuit Court, and the remaining 1.1% of cases were disposed in Juvenile Court.
