## **Section V:** Pretrial Release Trends

Section V presents data on the types of pretrial release used in the Commonwealth, as provided by the Kentucky Administrative Office of the Courts' (AOC), Department of Pretrial Services. The information reported in this section was obtained from the Pretrial Release Information Management (PRIM) System. Appendix D provides detailed information on the limitations of the data included in this section.

- In 2012, AOC's Pretrial Services processed 180,631 individuals. 130,076 (72.1%) of the individuals were males, and 50,054 (27.8%) were females. The remaining 501 individuals (<1%) involved persons of unknown or unreported gender.
- In 2012, there were 129,062 cases in which the judge set a financial bail amount. In these cases, 70,559 (54.7%), defendants were able to obtain pretrial release and in the remaining 58,503 (45.3%) defendants were still in custody or unable to obtain pretrial release.
- There were 101,821 cases in which the judge allowed release on recognizance or set another type of non-financial bail such as a surety or unsecured bond. In these cases, 94,455 (97.6%) were able to obtain pretrial release.
- AOC's Pretrial Services conducts a thorough investigation and utilizes a risk assessment on all defendants interviewed. In 2012, 75,103 defendants were assessed as low-risk, 76,940 assessed as moderate risk, and 19,879 assessed as high-risk. The release rate for low-risk defendants was 84%, 67% for moderate risk, and 54% for high-risk.
