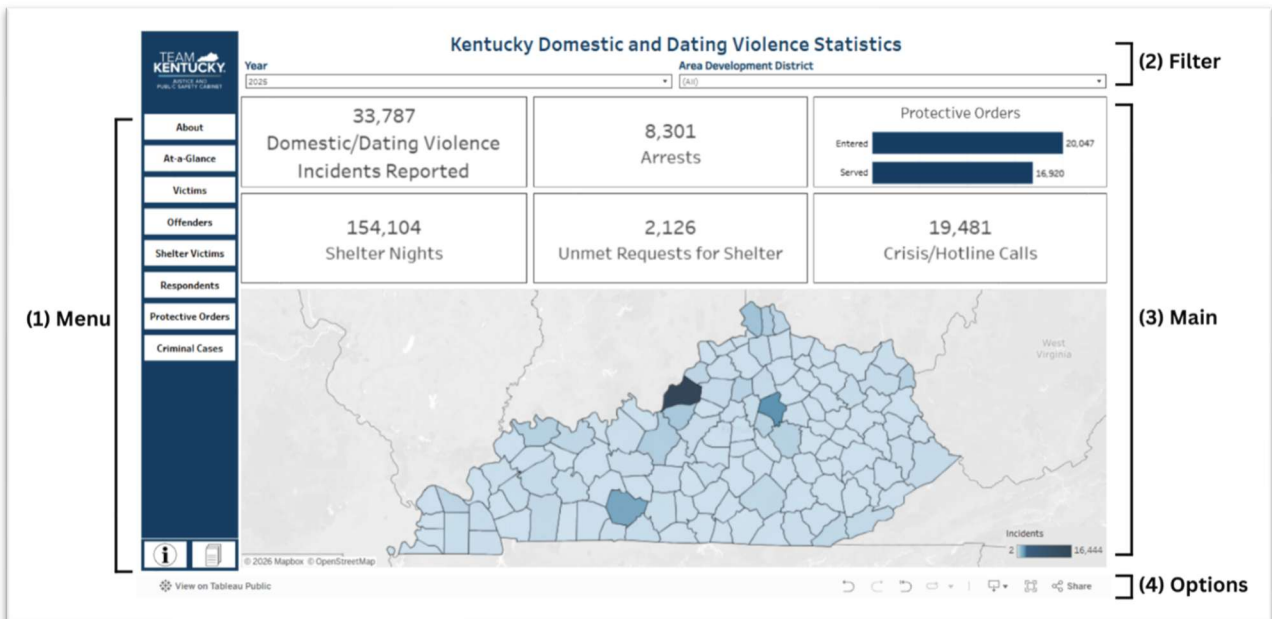
What is Tableau?

Tableau is a platform for creating and sharing data visualizations that allows users to explore large datasets interactively.

Overview of the Data Dashboard

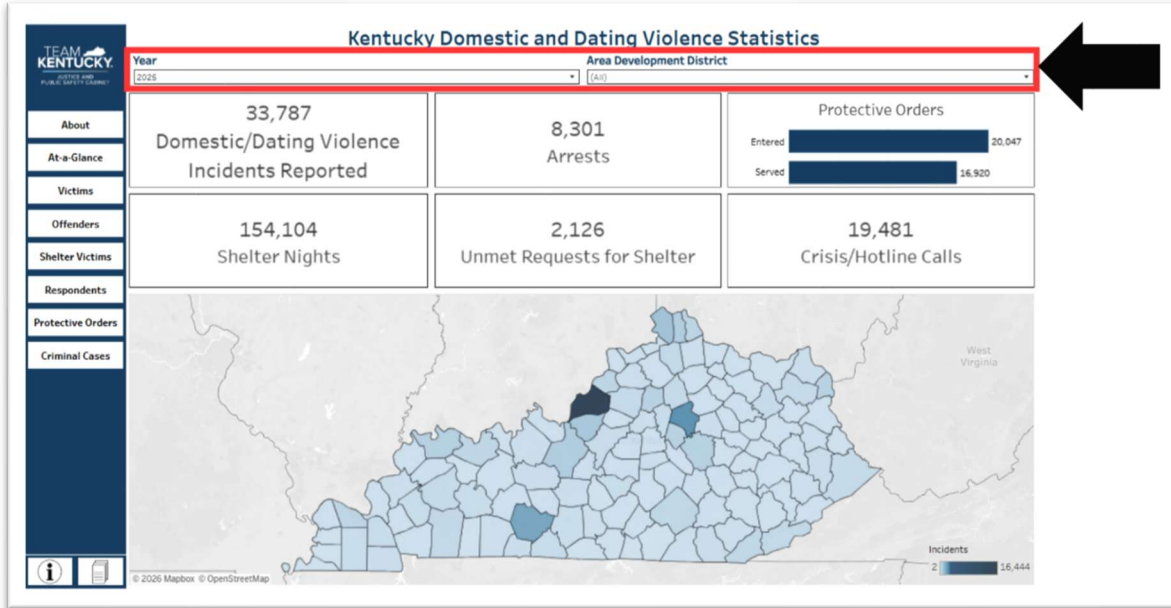
The dashboard is divided into four components:

1. **Menu tab** located on the left side of the page.
2. **Filter tab** located on the top of the page.
3. **Main page** that displays the data.
4. **Options tab** that displays Tableau-related actions (undo, reset, download, etc.).



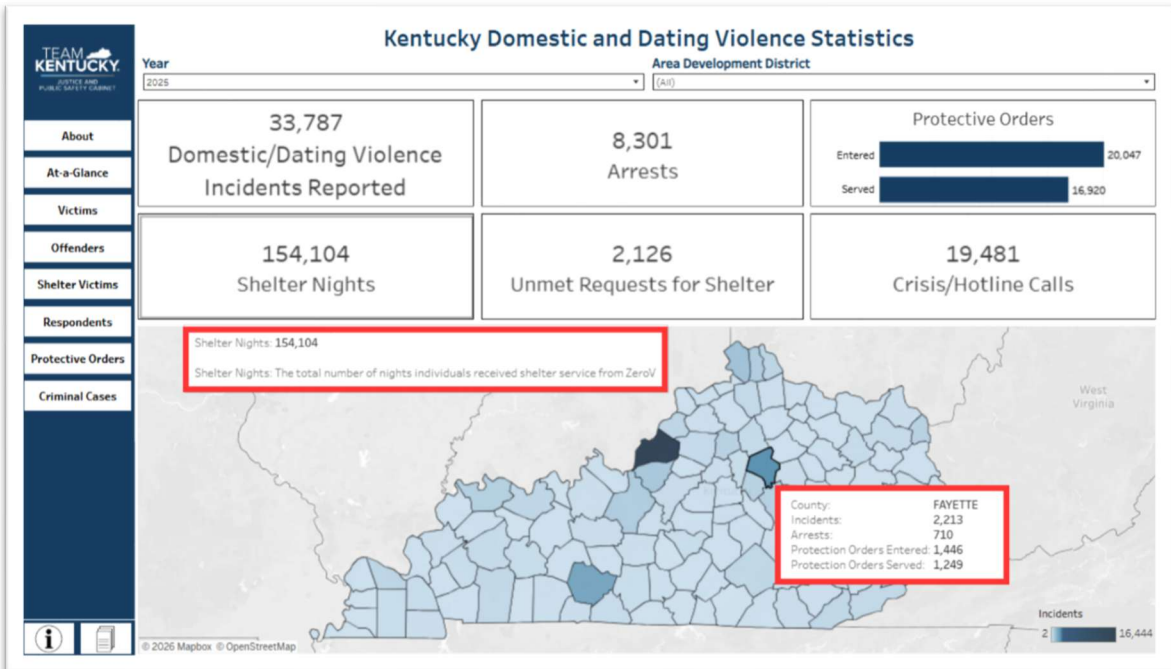
Filtering the Data

Each tab on the menu displays data from respective sources. Filter options will vary by tab. Filters expand or limit data shown on the main page. Changing filters will change the data displayed in tables and graphs.



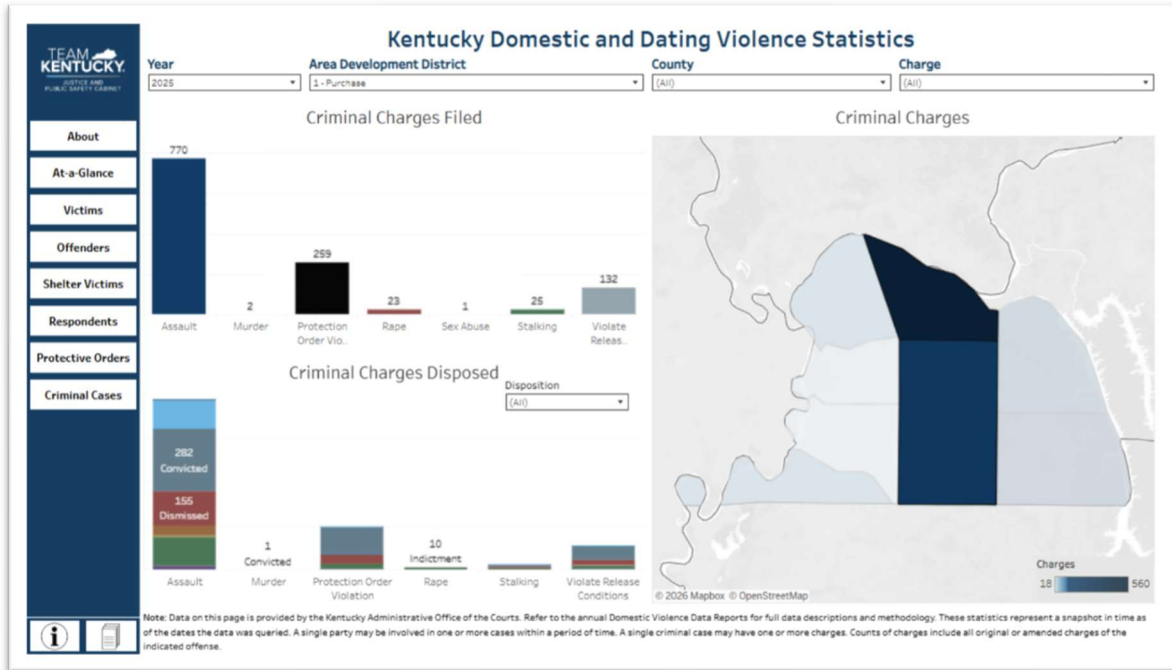
Tooltips

Tooltips are boxes that display additional information when the cursor is hovered over maps, graphs, tables, and buttons.



Using Maps to Filter Data

Clicking on a specific county/Area Development District on the map displays data for that area. To select multiple areas, hold down the Control (Ctrl) key and click on the county/Area Development District. When multiple areas are selected, combined data from selected areas will be displayed in the graphs.
